

Picasso Workshops

Two Offerings – One Line drawing (Contour) - 25 minute sessions
Still Life Collage – 40-minute sessions

Who: Single classes of students meet with actor for workshops.

What: Workshop lessons may be either of the following topics:

One-Liners (based on Picasso's one line drawing of "Rooster," seen in Performance.

Still Life - Collage based on Picasso's "Violin and Music Sheet"

Where: In an Art room or classroom setting with chairs and tables.

When: Following the assembly performances.

How Long: One-Liner sessions are 25 minutes. Collage sessions are 40 minutes.

Supplies: Art teachers are asked to supply the following:

For One-Liner Lessons – Large size white paper (9 x 12) and one sheet larger black paper (12 x 18) and pencils.

For Collage Lessons – Glue, scissors, (9 x 12) construction paper in blue, brown/ orange, black, white. Large Black Construction Paper (12 x 18) We will provide the music sheets.

Calder Workshops

Elementary (gr 2-4): Simple Mobile.

Supplies: Art teachers are asked to supply the following: Foam sheets or card stock, metal hangers (one per student), string or pipe cleaners, hole punch, stencils (optional).

Description:

1. Wire Hangers serve as the main sculpture.
2. Three Shapes are traced and then cut from cardstock or foam in bright colors. Thematic shapes may be encouraged to decorate the halls.
3. Punch holes into shapes. Write name on one shape.
4. Yarn, strings or pipe cleaners are tied to the bottom of the hanger. Attached to those are the shapes.
5. For younger grades, you could use stencils for shapes and pipe cleaners instead of string.

Time: 45 minutes

Intermediate (gr 5-6) Wire Fish

Supplies: Art teachers are asked to supply the following: Dry Cleaners thin wire hangers (one per student), beads, and/or buttons, pipe cleaners, soft wire pieces (Twisteez brand or long Christmas ornament hooks)

Description:



- ❖ Bend hangers into shape of fish.
- ❖ Wrap fish shape with pipe cleaners to cover wire. Tip: Bend pipe in half and wrap from center in two directions instead of from one end.
- ❖ String beads and buttons onto soft wire sections and attach to the top and bottom of fish outline to portray 'scales' ~ Tip: loose loops or knots can hold beads in place and add to sculpture.



Time: 45 minutes
